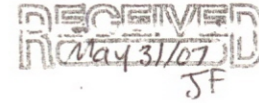

RE: First Draft submissions – May 31, 2007


Eagle Plains Resources Ltd. is a junior exploration company exploring for base metals and minerals in the Mackenzie Mountains of the Sahtu region. At the writing of this letter, Eagle Plains Resources Ltd. holds 37 prospecting permits as well as 11 staked mineral claims. Rather extensive portions of land under these prospecting permits and mineral claims fall within what is shown on the initial map with the draft plan as being in a "Conservation Zone", which does not allow for any exploration work of any kind to take place. We would like to express our concern over this particular issue at this time.

We have not had ample time to carefully consider the entire first draft of the land use plan. The mineral exploration industry's biggest time restraints happen between January and June of any given year in preparing for the upcoming field season. Of particular concern are the sections dealing with mineral exploration/mining/geology etc. being virtually non-existent at this point. We don't feel that we can properly make comments in that respect.

We request from the Board today, an extension of time for submitting comments until at least November 1, 2007, to submit our initial comments with respect to the Land Use Plan both generally and specifically relating to the sections that deal with mineral exploration overall. We would like the opportunity of working directly with the Board in an effort to bring those sections dealing with mineral exploration to the point where it would enable constructive comments on those sections.
