**Re: Preparation for Follow-up Consultation between SLUPB, Tulita and Norman Wells Community Organizations, January 6-7, 2011 in Tulita**

Dear Sirs and Madam,

The SLUPB has scheduled a follow-up consultation with community organizations from both Norman Wells and Tulita as requested by your organizations. The meeting is set for January 6-7, 2011 in Tulita. It will run from 9 am to 5 pm both days and will be held in the Community Hall. A draft agenda is attached. The SLUPB requests that the Board of Directors from each organization attend as decisions are required. The meeting is open to the public.

The purpose of this meeting is to seek clarity from your organizations on how the Tulita district should be zoned in the land use plan (both Crown and Settlement lands), and to follow-up on other comments submitted by your organizations. The meeting will focus on the establishment of Naats'ihch'oh, Shuhtagot'ine Nene, and the zone changes requested by the Tulita District Land Corporation for Settlement Lands.

In response to community requests for more information, the SLUPB has invited representatives from all parties involved or affected by establishment of the two candidate protected areas to attend the meeting and bring their information with them. The Board's goal is to facilitate an open exchange of information and perspectives on these areas to assist your community organizations in making the best decision for your future. Invitees include representatives from Parks Canada, the Protected Areas Strategy, the Canadian Wildlife Service, INAC, GNWT, SSI, and mineral exploration companies with interests in the region.

Given the recent community uncertainty in regards to establishment of these protected areas and zoning, we will be asking for resolutions from your organizations to support the outcome of this meeting, either at the meeting or immediately following it. We encourage you to meet with your membership beforehand and share your visions for the district with each other to arrive at a district level consensus on zoning prior to our meeting.

The Board postponed its public hearing in response to your requests for more time to determine how you want the land used. I must emphasize that we cannot move forward with a public hearing until we have clear consensus from the district on how you want the land zoned. We have heard many times how urgent it is to complete the Sahtu Land Use Plan. Please help the Board complete the Plan by coming prepared to make final decisions at this meeting.
