Dear Edna,

I am in Tulita and am writing to advise you that I was scheduled to meet with the Board of Directors of the Tulita Renewable Resources Council this morning. Unfortunately the meeting had to be canceled due to the death of an elder from the community. I did meet with the President of the TRRC, David Menacho, this afternoon and he identified one issue that he wants to put forth for discussion during the meetings in November.

The issue is recommendation number 2 - wildlife monitors. Why is this a recommendation and not a general condition?

David and I also agreed that I would return to Tulita on October 18 in the hope that his full board will be available at that time. Therefore it is likely that they will put forward further issues at that time.

I am traveling to Norman Wells tomorrow afternoon and will meet various leaders from Tulita (they are in Norman wells attending a conference) tomorrow night and will report further on Thursday morning.
